The date and time of oral presentations will be according to the Conference Scientific Program which is available at the [conference website](#).

LOADING PRESENTATIONS

Presenting authors should upload their presentation (in Powerpoint format) on site at the allocated session room at least 30 minutes prior to their scheduled oral session, during the coffee/lunch break.

PRESENTATION DURATION

Oral Presentations (except for invited lectures) are allotted 15 minutes: 12 minutes for the presentation itself and 3 minutes for Questions & Answers.

The importance of keeping presentations on schedule is crucial; please run through your presentation beforehand and time it!

AUDIOVISUAL ASSISTANCE

In the session room a computer monitor will be available and one ISEKI_2014 Staff member for any required assistance with regards the provided audiovisual system.

OPTION: POSTER IN MY POCKET
