| Organization (30 points) | The type of presentation is relevant for the topic. | 0-10 |

| Content (40 points) | Introduction is attention-getting, lays out the problem well, and establishes a framework for the rest of the presentation. | 0-10 |

| | There is an obvious conclusion summarizing the presentation. | 0-10 |
