

Prof. Dr. Birgit Kopainsky



Birgit Kopainsky is a professor in System Dynamics at the University of Bergen in Norway. She holds a PhD in agricultural economics from ETH Zurich and a master's degree in Geography from the University of Zurich in Switzerland. She teaches at ETH Zurich as well as at the University of Bergen. In her research, professor Kopainsky explores the role that system dynamics analysis and modeling techniques play in facilitating transformation processes in social-ecological systems, such as the transition towards sustainable agri-food systems on local, national and international levels. She works in Europe and has done extensive fieldwork in Africa and Asia. She is currently leading research using system dynamics in the Swiss National Science Foundation Research Program 69 “Healthy Nutrition and Sustainable Food Production” and in the EU Horizon 2020 project “Towards Sustainable and Resilient EU Farming Systems (SURE-Farm)”.
